SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to students who received the highest averages in the first year of their technology.

ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

Presented to students who received outstanding marks in specific first year courses or who have demonstrated a combination of high academic standing, leadership, service and/or all-round achievement.

MALCOLM WICKSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP AND BCIT ALUMNI SCHOOL AWARD

Presented to outstanding students in the School. Students are nominated by the Technology Department, with the final selection made by the Dean.

ENTRANCE AWARDS

Presented to outstanding students entering first year of a technology program.

TUITION SCHOLARSHIPS

Awarded to students in technologies related to the forest industry, with selection based on standing in Term 1 (and preference given to students who are sons/daughters of donor company employees).
