

# Rising from the rubble



On schedule and on budget, construction of the new Downtown campus will be complete by September 1996. "The site at the corner of Dunsmuir and Seymour Streets is fairly impressive," says Marsh Heinekey, Special Projects coordinator "and you can already see the glazing going into the lower floors." The topping off, or completion of the top floor construction, is slated for the end of March. The new building replaces BCIT's facilities on Howe Street.

Once complete, the building will house retail outlets on the ground floor, BCIT's Downtown Campus on three and a half floors, and opportunities for organizations to lease office or training space on the upper floors. Four and a half

levels of underground parking are also included in the business plan. Among the BCIT facilities that have much to offer to business, industry and individuals will be the Performance Improvement Centre; the Small Business Centre; the Student Projects Centre; the Living Laboratory in conjunction with SFU; the Library/Resource Centre; Microcomputer Learning Facilities and the BCIT Seminar Centre.

The focus of BCIT's new Downtown campus will be driven and enriched by the training needs of downtown Vancouver businesses. As one of the top 50 "smart" buildings in the world, the building will offer telecommunications and information technology that will take us to the 21st century.

### In memorium



**Terence James (Terry) Garner**, longtime radio and television host, program director and BCIT instructor, died on January 6 of cancer at Eagle Ridge Hospital in Port Moody, BC.

Garner was born in Armstrong and was educated at Victoria College (now the University of Victoria) and UBC. During the Second World War he served with the RCAF. He then began a career in broadcasting and over the next twenty years worked as an announcer and program director

with stations in Vancouver, Victoria, Hamilton, Ontario; and Montreal. In recent years he wrote for the Knowledge Network and directed a number of video productions. He was best known as the host of the CBC-TV program "Reach for the Top," from 1961 to 1982.

From 1974 to 1991 he was a senior member of BCIT's Broadcast Communications faculty, where he was admired by students and colleagues alike. From Brian Antonson, Associate Dean of Broadcast Communications, "We've had a lot of calls from former students who learned a great deal from Terry while they were studying here. He challenged them and then expected the students to live up to the challenges. Those that did earned his respect. Some maintained their friendship with Terry long after leaving BCIT, and he'll be missed by them as well."

### What's Happening at BCIT

Let the kids dictate the show....

BCIT Physics instructor **Amar Kshatriya** became a volunteer two years ago for Scientists and Innovators in the Schools, a provincial program that brings science into the classrooms of children in Grades 4 to 7.

"Children are very curious and full of ideas," says Kshatriya. "I would not have otherwise guessed that they would become so excited about science." The program is a joint venture between the provincial government and Science World, and endeavours to stimulate interest in the sciences in a fun and exciting way. And exciting it is! Kshatriya's ability to transform topics like energy and various forms of matter into exciting, engaging demonstrations for young people has been enjoyed by more than 1500 children throughout B.C.

Kshatriya is assisted by his wife, Savita, and together they travel all over B.C. in a car that is filled to the brim with all kinds of equipment to give students a scientific thrill. They also come equipped with posters, pens and T-shirts by sponsors MacDonald Dettwiler, BC Hydro and BCIT. A day of presentations at one school often lasts the



entire day, as the pair speak to groups of 25 for an hour at a time. The scientist introduces concepts like light, electricity, magnetism, muscle energy and magnetism, and even touches on the idea of atmospheric pressure.

"I take it upon myself as an instructor at BCIT to promote an interest in science and technology in children today, because they must have some literacy in those topics to survive in the 21st century," he says. "I neven have an agenda, it depends on the questions they ask. It's better to let the kids dictate the show."
